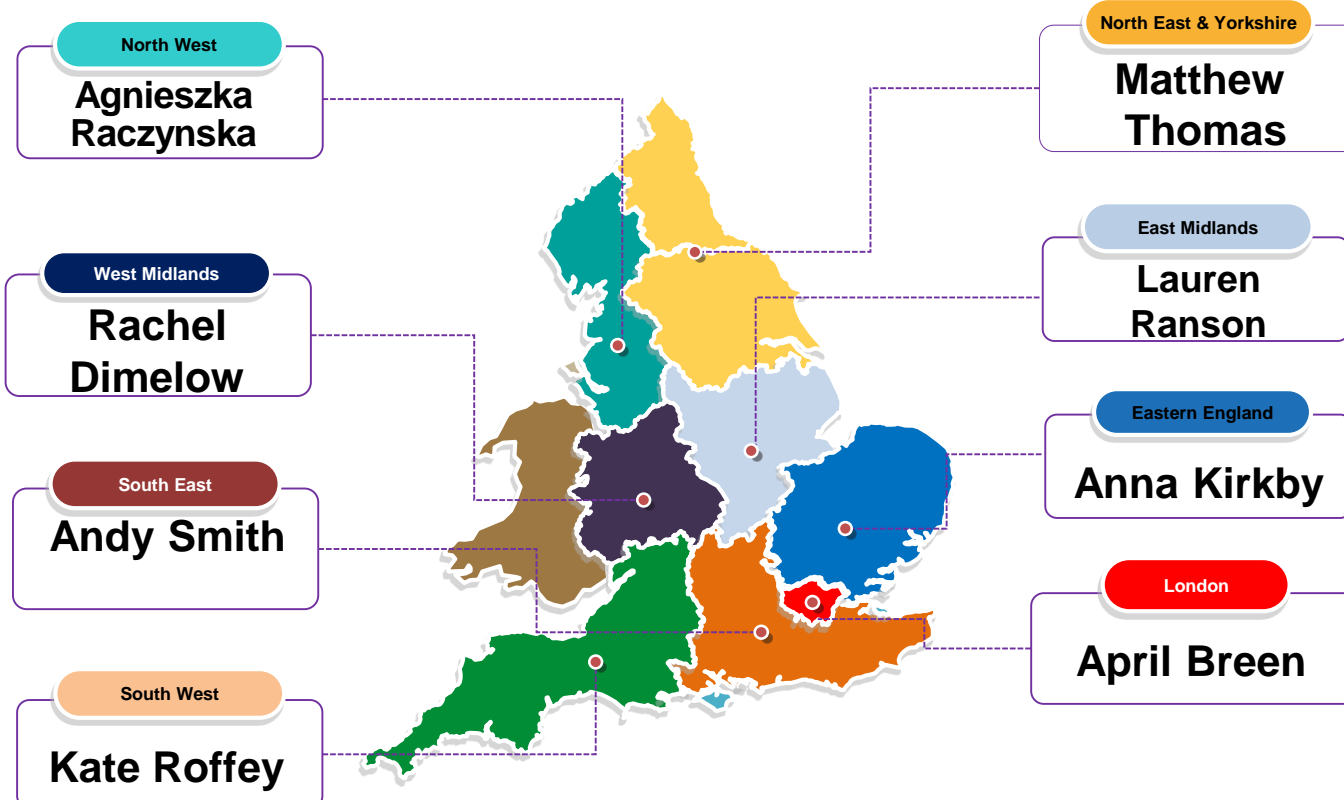

# Regional Safeguarding & Prevent Officers



Your **Regional Safeguarding and Prevent Officer** is a trained member of staff from the apprenticeship team.



**They will post regular 'Workplace' updates and/or links to resources every week with clear guidance on how to effectively implement the resource and information into various delivery models.**



They will have the responsibility for providing advice and support to staff, liaising with the Local Authorities to obtain safeguarding and Prevent updates and work with a range of other agencies (applicable to their allocated region) these updates will include those obtained from their Government Regional Prevent Coordinator.

They will refer cases of suspected abuse to the Designated Safeguarding Lead and the Deputy Designated Safeguarding Lead.



They will refer cases to the Designated Safeguarding Lead and the Deputy Designated Safeguarding Lead where there is a radicalisation concern as required.

Your RSPO will support staff who escalate concerns.

# Regional Safeguarding & Prevent Officers

Your RSPO will ensure Pareto Law's Safeguarding & Prevent policies are known, understood and used appropriately within their region.

They will liaise with the Designated Safeguarding Lead and the Deputy Designated Safeguarding Lead to inform of any immediate issues and key updates.

They will make links with the Local Safeguarding Boards to make sure staff are aware of any training opportunities and the latest local policies on local safeguarding arrangements.

Your RSPO will contribute to the design and delivery of staff CPD related to safeguarding and prevent.

They will link with their region's Local Safeguarding Council Boards and Regional Prevent Coordinators.

They will attend the Quarterly Pareto Apprenticeships Safeguarding Committee meeting and provide regional updates.

Your Regional Safeguarding and Prevent Officer will undergo training to provide them with the knowledge and skills required to carry out the role.

# Regional Safeguarding & Prevent Officers

**Regional Safeguarding and Prevent Officers will undertake Prevent awareness training.**

In addition to the required formal training your RSPOs knowledge and skills will be regularly refreshed to ensure they understand and keep up to date with any developments relevant to the role.

## Regional Safeguarding & Prevent Officers will:

- Understand the assessment process for providing early help and statutory intervention, including local criteria for action.
- Have a working knowledge of how local authorities operate and what their key priorities are.
- Ensure each member of staff has access to, and understands, Pareto Apprenticeships Safeguarding and Prevent policy and procedures, especially new and part time staff are alert to the specific needs of vulnerable learners, those with special educational needs and young carers.
- Understand and support Pareto Apprenticeships with regards to the requirements of the Prevent duty and are able to provide advice and support to staff on protecting children and adults at risk from the risk of radicalisation.
- Are able to understand the unique risks associated with online safety and be confident that you have the relevant knowledge and up to date capability required to keep children and adults at risk safe whilst they are online.
- Can recognise the additional risks that children and adults at risk with SEN and disabilities (SEND) face online, for example, from online bullying, grooming and radicalisation.
- Obtain access to resources and attend any relevant or refresher training courses.
- Encourage a culture of listening to children and adults at risk and taking account of their wishes and feelings.
